Letterman Jacket Criteria

To be eligible for a NJROTC Letterman Jacket a cadet must be enrolled in the NJROTC Program for a minimum of **three consecutive school years** and meet the following eligibility requirements:

1. Complete three years on a competitive NJROTC Special Teams:
 - Armed Drill Team (ADT), Unarmed Drill Team (UADT)
 - Rifle Team (RT)-required to shoot 285 average on qualification year
2. Attend **ALL** practices, unless excused by the instructor and have competed in **ALL** drills for that year.
3. Have "B" (3.5) GPA in NJROTC and overall school GPA of "C" (2.7) or higher.
4. Submit a 250 word essay on "What can I do to serve my country better."
5. Must have completed 300 community service hours.
6. Know, represent and embrace the Navy Core Values; Honor, Courage, Commitment.

Instructor will make recommendation to Senior Naval Instructor. Senior Naval Instructor will review cadet's recommendations based, but not limited to cadet's loyalty and performance of duties to the program. Attitude and behavior when participating and/or representing the Socorro NJROTC will be equally considered with the aforementioned qualification as well as a cadet being in GOOD STANDING and proactive in the unit.

The Socorro NJROTC Instructors will review the performance record of all potential jacket recipients. Recipients will be measured on their Junior/Senior year. If cadet demonstrates a conduct that falls below standards during the qualification year, they will **NOT** receive the Letterman Jacket. Depending on the infraction, NJROTC instructors will provide guidance to the cadet. If a cadet has received a Letterman Jacket from another organization, cadet will only receive a "Letter". Special Teams Cord will also be provided to seniors that met Jacket criteria.


Senior Cords Criteria

This program has two cords one for special teams members (navy blue & black) and the other for other cadets (black & gold). To receive cords a cadet must and meet the following eligibility requirements:

Special teams must follow Letterman Jacket criteria above to receive cord.

Other cadets must be enrolled in the NJROTC Program for a minimum of **two years** and must meet criteria below.

- Student must not have had any type of discipline (specifically Level II or higher).
- Completed 300 hours of community service.
- Have "B" (3.5) GPA in NJROTC.
- Must be enrolled in program their Senior Year for at least one semester.
- Must have paid enrichment fees and meet the cord order deadline in January of graduating year.
