**Peims #03500100**

**Recommended Grade Placement: 9-12**

**(ART 1)**

**1 credit – state**

Prerequisite: None

This is an introductory course that will explore art history, art criticism, composition, careers in art, and various art media in design, drawing, painting, printmaking, and sculpture.

### **A903/A904 ART I, ART APPRECIATION**

**Peims # 03500110**

**Recommended Grade Placement: 9-12**

**(ART1APP)**

**1 credit – state**

Prerequisites: None

This course is a study of art forms that a civilization deems important: religion, love, political change and commerce. It aims to help one learn about the people who produce art.

### **A105/A106 ART III –DRAWING II**

**Peims #03501300**

**Recommended Grade Placement: 11-12**

**(ART 3DRAW)**

**1 credit – state**

Prerequisite: A103/A104 Art II - DRAWING

This course is a continuation of Art II - Drawing. As students advance they are expected to become more independent and self-directed. This course includes development of a personal portfolio and research on an art career of the student's choice.

### **A107/A108 ART IV – DRAWING III**

**Recommended Grade Placement: 12**

**(ART4DRAW)**

**1 credit – state**

Prerequisite: A105/A106 ART III - DRAWING

Students will continue to investigate careers and contemporary art styles in preparation for jobs that require sculpture skills or to continue in college level art studies.

**A907/A908 ART II, DIGITAL ART AND MEDIA I**

**(ART2GMD)**

**Peims: 03501220 Recommended Grade Placement: 10-12**

**1 credit – state**

Prerequisites: None

This lab course is the introduction of technology using an artistic focus. Students will learn to use image manipulation programs and traditional drawing, painting, photography and layout techniques. Students will view the computer as an important tool for the artist and use computer programs to facilitate the design process of exploring, developing ideas and producing finished work. Students will learn the basics of hardware and a variety of art software programs.

**A441/A442 ART III, DIGITAL ART AND MEDIA II**

Students will continue to investigate careers and contemporary art styles in preparation for jobs that require photography skills or to continue in college level art studies.

**A127/A128 ART II – PAINTING I**

**1 credit – state**

Prerequisite: A101/A102 ART I

This course is a comprehensive study and application of painting techniques in a variety of media. Composition, art criticism, careers and art history are also studied.

**A129/A130 ART III – PAINTING II**

**(ART3PATG)**

**Peims #03501400 Recommended Grade Placement: 11-12**

**1 credit – state**

Prerequisite: A127/A128 Art II - PAINTING

This course is a continuation of Art II - Painting. As students advance they are expected to become more independent and self-directed. This course includes development of a personal portfolio and research on an art career of the student's choice.

**A131/A132 ART IV - PAINTING III**

**(ART4PATG)**

**Peims #03502400 Recommended Grade Placement: 12**

**1 credit – state**

Prerequisite: A129/A130 ART III - PAINTING

This course is a continuation of Art III – Painting. It focuses on the development of a personal portfolio in painting and a senior exhibition that shows a high level of creativity and expertise using art history as a source of interpretation. Students will continue to investigate careers and contemporary art styles in preparation for jobs that require painting skills or to continue in college level art studies.

**A133/A134 AP STUDIO ART – (2-D DESIGN PORTFOLIO)**

**(AP2DDP)**

**Peims #A3500400 Recommended Grade Placement: 10-12**

**1 credit – state**

Weight: Reference District Policy EIC Local as weights are dependent upon high school year entry date.

Prerequisite: 3 years of art, additional requirements may be imposed at individual campuses.

This portfolio is intended to address a very broad interpretation of two-dimensional (2-D) design issues. This type of design involves purposeful decision-making about how to use the elements and principles of art in an integrative way. For this portfolio, students are asked to demonstrate proficiency in 2-D design using a variety of art forms. These could include, but are not limited to, graphic design, typography, digital imaging, photography, collage, fabric design, weaving, illustration, painting, printmaking, etc. Students submit portfolio for evaluation at the end of the school year.

**A135/A136 AP STUDIO ART (3 –D DESIGN PORTFOLIO)**

**(AP3DDP)**

**Peims #A3500500 Recommended Grade Placement: 11-12**

**1 credit – state**

Weight: Reference District Policy EIC Local as weights are dependent upon high school year entry date.

Prerequisite: 3 years of art, additional requirements may be imposed at individual campuses.

This portfolio is intended to address a broad interpretation of sculptural issues in depth and space. These may include mass, volume, form, plane, light, and texture. Such elements and concepts may be articulated through additive, subtractive, and/or fabrication processes. A variety of approaches to representation, abstraction, and expression sculpture, architectural models, apparel, ceramics, three-dimensional fiber arts or metal work, among others. Students submit portfolio for evaluation at the end of the school year.

**A137/A138 AP ART DRAWING**

**(APSTARTD)**

**Peims #A3500300 Recommended Grade Placement: 11-12**

**1 credit – state**

Weight: Reference District Policy EIC Local as weights are dependent upon high school year entry date.

Prerequisite: 3 years of art, additional requirements may be imposed at individual campuses.

The Drawing Portfolio is designed to address a very broad interpretation of drawing issues and media. Light and shade, line quality, rendering of form, composition, surface manipulation, and illusion of depth

are drawing issues that can be addressed through a variety of means. Many works of painting, printmaking, and mixed media, as well as abstract, observational, and inventive works, may qualify. The range of marks used to make drawings, the arrangement of those marks, and the materials used to make the marks are endless. Students submit their portfolio for evaluation at the end of the school year.

**A807/A808 VISUAL ARTS SLA IB (El Dorado High School only) (IBARTSL)**

Weight: Reference District Policy EIC Local as weights are dependent upon high school year entry date.  
Prerequisite: IB Guidelines  
Students engage in advanced research of art processes, aesthetic issues, art criticism, and art history and culture. Students will exhibit in verbal, written and graphic forms how their research has led them to and understanding of selected topics. Students are **required** to maintain a sketch book/journal or research workbook which shows evidence of critical research in an area agreed upon by the teacher and student.

**A809/A810 VISUAL ARTS HL IB (El Dorado High School only) (IBARTHL)**
