- B103/B104 PALs I – PEER ASSISTANCE AND LEADERSHIP (PAAL1)**
Peims # N1290005 Recommended Grade Placement: 9-12 1 credit - state
Prerequisite: Teachers must be trained by sponsoring organization; teacher approval.
A peer assistance program offering selected high school students the opportunity to work as peer facilitators with other students on their own campuses and/or from feeder middle and elementary school.

P509/P510 SPORTS MEDICINE III (SPORTMD3)
