Ms. Analicia Bañales presented the Texas Hunger Initiative which develops partnerships with Texas schools to implement best practices for school meals programs, mobilizes communities to better support school nutrition initiatives and helps school administrations coordinate with the USDA and TDA for benefits through the Community Eligibility Provision. She presented a video of H.D. Hilley Middle School Child Nutrition Services staff as it is one of the schools currently under participation.
