III. TEXAS KIDS DENTAL

Texas Kids Dental offers orthodontic services with a welcoming environment, friendly and well-trained staff/doctors. They work as Partners in Education through different schools. Services offered to students are career day presentations, participation in Health Fairs, donations to schools and participation in the campus' science fairs. They also offer Oral Hygiene presentations teach our students about the importance of brushing, flossing, prevention/cause of cavities, gum diseases, importance of visiting the dentist as well as the pros of eating healthy and cons of eating unhealthy. They provide goodies for students such as a new toothbrush and floss. They also provide in-office activities such as parent oral hygiene classes, craft/game/music/science nights, movie nights, CrossFit classes, holiday parties, daycare presentations and smile cards. Texas Kids dental presents at elementary, middle and high school level. The SHAC council voted yes to Texas Kids Dental.

IV. ATLANTIS HEALTH SERVICES

Atlantis Health Services offers services for Anger Management, Management of Depression and Anxiety, Medication Training and Support, Improvement of Social Skills, Education to Consumers about Psychiatric Treatment and Individualized Goal Setting. Services may be offered at home or at school as long as clearance is given. They have a Skills Training Program for Adolescents which include individual sessions to target areas of concern. Atlantis Health Services has been working with patients for 10 years. They uphold values of empathy and respect through the services provided. Services would not be provided directly at the school; however, they can work with students older than 11 and staff at their offices, offering free assessment evaluations. SHAC Council voted yes to Atlantis Health Services.

V. NEW BUSINESS

Texas A&M Agricultural Life representative Virginia Galarza, SHAC Approved Vendor, announced the Texas A&M Annual Kids, Cows & More annual event at the County Coliseum taking place in March. They offer funds and transportation for kids to attend if booked with time prior to the event. SHAC council discussed on school concerns brought up by parent representatives such as the lack of lockers at the school bringing up a problem of heavy backpacks in middle schools. Lunch menus were also a point of discussion, to which Mrs. Shelley Chenausky, CNS director, answered questions to and invited all parents and community to join her CNS Advisory Council in which concerns are brought up and the council votes on menu plans; the first meeting will take place September 28th at 5:30 p.m. Alejandra Salgado, new Secretary V for Health Services introduced herself to the members of SHAC, she will be the new point of contact and will organize SHAC meetings/presentations as well as work with the different agencies and representatives serving our students.
