

SISD AQUATICS: GENERAL RULES/ADMISSION POLICIES



The following rules and regulations have been established for the benefit of all users of the swimming facility to assure the safe operation of the pool facilities and to provide enjoyable recreation for all. Patrons are requested to cooperate in observing these rules and to obey the instructions of the aquatics staff. Patrons violating swimming rules are subject to the revocation of their swimming privileges.

SISD reserves the right to refuse admittance into the Aquatic swimming facility when the capacity of the pool has been reached and when otherwise deemed necessary for the health, welfare or safety of patrons.

The Aquatic Technician or designee is responsible for the operation of the pool. Their instructions must be followed at all times. Should a disagreement arise, patrons are advised to contact the Pool Supervisor .

1. No one will be allowed in the swimming area unless the pool is officially open and a lifeguard is on duty. Entering upon the pool premises when it is not open for public use is punishable by fines imprisonment or both.
2. Anyone that wears a disposable under garment and wishes to enter the pool must wear a disposable under garment that is designed for swim use, which must fit snugly around the legs and waist. If the garment becomes soiled, this person must leave the pool immediately, and may not return until he/she has taken or been given a soap shower and has been recovered by a new garment.
3. SISD assumes no liability for injuries or damages arising from the results of participation unless due to willful or gross negligence on the part of SISD. Due to the strenuous nature of some activities the participant is advised to consult his/her physician concerning fitness to participate. All activities present contain inherent risks and hazards which the participant assumes.
4. Admission fees must be paid by all persons to include infants that are 1 year of age or older. Spectators must pay upon each entry session to the pool facility.
5. Rain checks will only be given when the facility must be closed due to weather conditions or equipment malfunction. They will be issued to patrons admitted within 30 minutes of the closure. The patron must produce the receipt with the time and date on it.
6. All patrons within the pool area must be attired in swimming apparel. The swimming pool and decks must be maintained in a sanitary manner for the protection of bathers.
7. Children 12 and under entering the pool facility must be escorted and directly supervised by an adult or responsible person 18 years old.
8. Children 6 years and younger must be accompanied and directly supervised, within arms reach of an adult at all times in the water and within the facility.
9. Groups of children 6 or more and ages 6-17 entering the pool must be directly supervised at poolside by an adult in swim attire. There must be one adult for every six children. Groups must contact pool management before coming to facility. Groups with children under 6 years of age must provide 1 adult per child in the water.
10. Food or refreshments may be consumed only in designated eating areas. All refuse and waste papers must be deposited in designated receptacles. Food is not permitted in the locker rooms.
11. No grills, gas or electric cooking devices may be brought into the pool facility/grounds.
12. Glass containers, alcoholic beverages, smoking, drugs, and pets are not permitted in the pool facilities. An exception will be made for service animals.
13. Leave all valuables at home. SISD assumes no liability for personal property or valuables at any time. Lockers are available for daily use only. Locks will be cut if left on over night. Valuables may not be checked with the attendant or pool staff.
14. Persons under the influence of alcohol or drugs will not be permitted in the pool facility or in the surrounding areas.
15. No person within the pool grounds shall behave in such a manner as to jeopardize the safety and health of him/her and others. Such behavior including abusive or profane language, shall be grounds for expulsion.
16. Loitering will not be permitted on the pool grounds or within the facility.
17. Prior to entering the pool facility, any patron requiring reasonable accommodations for a disability must inform staff of his/her needs. Such a person may provide a personal care attendant at no additional charge.
18. Any injury occurring in the pool area must be reported to the pool staff immediately.
19. The office telephone and public address equipment may only be used by staff to deliver messages of an emergency nature or facility information to persons at the pool.
20. Patrons are not allowed in the guard room, filter room, mechanical room, storage room, or offices.
21. The use of cameras, video cameras or any device containing camera equipment of any kind is prohibited in the locker rooms, bathrooms, and changing facilities. All cameras must be registered at the front desk upon entering the facility.
