We offer a multitude of programs for scholars, starting from our 3 years old Program to Dual Credit classes and Early College High Schools. Socorro ISD is proud to have 45 schools that have been awarded the prestigious Texas Purple Star Campus Designation by the Texas Education Agency for supporting military-connected students and families.

High School Advanced Academies and Programs of Study

Americas High School: Libertas Academy – Provides participants the opportunity to explore the areas of constitutional and trial law. Students will graduate with a Public Service endorsement.

Eastlake High School: School of Advanced Technology Applications (SATA) Academy – Students will learn different programming languages and explore areas such as Robotics, Database, Game Program Design, Mobil Applications and Digital Forensics. Students will graduate with a STEM endorsement.

El Dorado High School: International Baccalaureate (IB) – An academically challenging educational program with final examinations that prepare students for success at university and life beyond. Students will graduate with a STEM endorsement.

Montwood High School: Synergy4 Academy– Learning community that utilizes a curriculum that is project based, that reflect real word applications which allows students to develop 21st century skills of competency, collaboration, communication, critical and creative thinking while earning college credit and graduating with a STEM endorsement

Socorro High School: Health Professions Academy (HPA) – Designed for students interested in health professions career, including dentistry, emergency technician or pharmacy technician. Students will graduate with a Public Service endorsement.

Pebble Hills High School Sparta Business Academy – Designed to prepare students for college and career-readiness in the fields of Accounting, Finance, and Economics.
