- **Technology**
  - *We are considering replacing projectors as bulbs as giving out, or also into technology teachers can use.*
  - *Our goal is to take advantage of grants and scholarships offered for technology, SIT will work on them next year.*
- **Concerns**
  - *1<sup>st</sup> grade: Not all grade levels received A honor roll medals.*
    - *There was a discrepancy in the estimated number of medals that would be purchased for the campus. Leadership made decision to start with STAAR grades and work way down and cover as many grade levels as possible.*
  - *1<sup>st</sup>/2<sup>nt</sup> grade: Kindergarten received medals for completing of kindergarten while there was not enough A honor medals purchased for A Honor Roll for rest of grade levels. Second grade teachers felt that some grade levels receiving A Honor roll medals while others didn't was unfair.*
    - *Due to the discrepancy in the estimates and actual counts, not all A honor roll medals were purchased. A new system will be set in place to determine the number of medals that will be needed for awards at the end of the year for the campus. We will improve our system by possibly recognizing A honor rolls per grading period to have a continuous estimate.*
    - *Relaying message to parents and students in a positive manner.*
  - *3<sup>rd</sup> grade: Better organization for end of the year awards.*
    - *There was confusion on medals and award ceremonies, we were told during faculty meeting that if teachers purchased medals with their own money, they would not be distributed during awards. It was suggested to go back to last year's system which seemed more effective.*
  - *3<sup>rd</sup> grade: New ELAR adoption trainings*
    - *Can district offer training for ELAR adoption prior to staff development week so teachers may familiarize themselves with resource before beginning of the year.*
      - *Mr. Macias will train all teachers on new adoption*
  - *1<sup>st</sup> grade: Lesson Plan template revision: can we change lesson plan template? (too wordy)*
    - *Template will be looked at for next school year. We can create a new one during staff development week.*
  - *5<sup>th</sup> grade: Feeder pattern shirts?*
    - *Will be brought up during Principal feeder pattern meeting.*
