This free Dyslexia Professional Learning Course is designed for all school and district staff members across the state who serve students in kindergarten through grade 12.

This course consists of four modules and meets the requirement for “an educator who teaches students with dyslexia must include training regarding new research and practices in educating students with dyslexia” (TEC §21.054(b)).

The purpose of this course is to empower educators to serve and advocate for students with or at risk for dyslexia.

- Module 1: Learn more about what dyslexia is and how it impacts student learning.
- Module 2: Explore effective schoolwide practices for the identification and support of students with dyslexia.
- Module 3: Learn more about how to support students with dyslexia in the classroom through systematic, explicit, and evidence-based instruction designed to meet the needs of students with dyslexia.
- Module 4: Reflect on your learning, create a personal action plan, and review resources.

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
