Attendance and Tardies

What to do if you are absent:

There is a forty-eight (48) hour time limit in which to notify the attendance office in writing as to the reason(s) for absence(s). In cases where students will be absent for more than three days, the attendance office will need a doctor's note.

Loss of Credit:

If a student is absent **NINE** or more days (excused or unexcused) during the semester for any single class, the student will lose credit (LOC) whether or not the student passed the class. Students who lose credit will see "LOC" on their report card in lieu of the grade they earned. Credits can be regained through a loss of credit contract, which will be offered at the end of each semester and must be completed within 30 days of the end of the semester for which they lost credit.

Tardy and Lockouts

Tardy Policy and Lock Outs:

When arriving tardy, students will report directly to their class where the Teacher will document student tardy through the Tyler Student Information System.

Note: Lockouts will be conducted randomly 3 to 5 times a week and will be tracked by the Attendance office. Students caught in a lockout will follow the lockout matrix above.

Truancy

Truancy:

Parents and students must be in compliance with the Texas Education Code Chapter 25: School Attendance Laws. **When a student fails to attend school on 9 or more days or parts of days within a six month period in the same school year; or three or more days with in a four week period, the school will file court charges in accordance with Texas Code Chapter 25.** Under Senate Bill 247, parents/students are responsible to the court until the age of 19 or older. It is imperative that absences are **excused**.

Grading Procedures

- Every effort should be made to assist all students to achieve mastery of the Texas Essential Knowledge and Skills
- Students will have two days for each day absent to make up missed work
- 1st Eligibility check is at 6 weeks mark (September 7, 2019)

Grading

REDO's

- It shall be the **parent and/or student's responsibility** to seek the opportunity to **redo an assignment or test** for which he/she received a failing grade **within five school days** upon which he/she *received notification of a failing*



Grading

- The *grade earned when redoing* an assignment or test shall be **averaged** with the *grade earned on the first attempt*, and the averaged grade shall replace the failing grade.



Dress Code

NOT permitted:

- Short shorts or skirts (must be to finger tip length)
- Over-sized clothing or pants that sag, especially where under garments are exposed
- Spikes and chains as facial piercings
- Attire that represents gang affiliation, depicts satanic messages, or profane or sexually inappropriate content
- Attire/jewelry/accessories promoting drugs or alcohol
- No low cut blouses, halter tops, racer backs, tube tops, spaghetti straps, or strapless attire even if worn with a sweater and tank top straps must be 3 fingers thick
- **Mid torso cannot be visible at any time**
- Exposed undergarments
- Caps, hats, bandanas or do-rags in the building
- Weapon-like accessories
- Slippers, house shoes, or pajamas
- **No excessively torn jeans (see examples)**

ID's and Safety

Student ID's

- All ID's are purchased at the business office for \$5.00 and picked up in Rm A227
- ID's must be worn at ALL times
- Incentives for wearing your ID will also take place periodically

Consequences for not having an ID

- 1st Offense – student will be given a warning and a free temporary ID
- 2nd Offense – student will be charged \$1.00 for a temporary ID
- 3rd Offense – student will be charged \$1.00 for a temporary ID and will have lunch detention
- 4th Offense – student will be charged \$1.00 for a temporary ID and will be considered for an insubordination referral and possibly SAC

ID's and Safety

Visitors to the campus:

- Present a valid ID
- Come in through designated entrance only
- Will be escorted to their destination
- Wear visitor's badge at shoulder level

Electronic Devices

- For safety purposes, the district permits students to possess personal mobile telephones; however, these devices must remain turned off during the instructional day, especially during all testing, unless they are being used for approved instructional purposes.
- One earbud in at a time during transition/in hallway

Electronic Devices

- The first time that a telecommunications device is confiscated from a student, it will be returned to the student's parent, no earlier than Friday at 4:00 PM. In the event that the device is picked up on a Friday, the phone will not be released until the following Friday.
- The second time that the telecommunication device is confiscated, a fee of \$15.00 will be paid. Parent may pick up the device on Friday at 4 p.m.
- Telecommunication devices will only be held for a 30 day period. After time has expired, the district will dispose of the device.

Electronic Devices

- The district will not investigate lost, damage or stolen telecommunication devices. Students may file a report with SISD Police Services.
- Telecommunication devices may be picked up in the Assistant Principals office with Mrs. Rodriguez or Ms. Villarreal.
