ID's and Safety

Student ID's (part of dress code)

- **Must be worn at ALL times during school hours.**
- Can be purchased during registration for \$5.00 or at the business office if lost.
- Student may receive disciplinary action for no ID.
- Temporary ID's must be purchased for \$1.00 from the Assistant Principal's office every day the student does not have their ID

Visitors to the campus:

- Present valid ID
- Come in through Main entrance (Montwood Dr.)
- Escorted to their destination
- Wear Visitor's badge at shoulder level
- Return badge to Main entrance (Montwood Dr.)



MHS Dress Code

MHS prohibits any clothing or grooming that in the administration's judgment may reasonably be expected to cause disruption of or interference with normal school operations during school or school-related activities.

A few things to consider:

- Clothing with lewd, offensive, vulgar, or obscene images
- Items with inappropriate content or intent.
- Torn jeans
- Baggy/Sagging pants
- Mid torso may not be visible at any time
- Muscle shirts/spaghetti straps
- Slippers/Flip flops
- Caps, Beanies, Hoodies, Sunglasses

Attendance and Tardies

Attendance and Punctuality Matter
Every Day ALL Day

How do I report an Absence?

- Parent or guardian must email all excuses or doctor's notes to attendancemontwoodhs@sisd.net within 48 hours of the absence. Phone call notifications are not allowed as per TEA.
- A doctor's note is required in cases where student was absent more than 3 days.

Do tardies count as absences?

- Student must be in attendance at least 50% of the time to be counted present.
- Students with more than 3 tardies per semester in any one class risk disciplinary action.



Loss of Credit (LOC)

Loss of Credit

- **8** or more absences per semester (excused or unexcused) will give student LOC
- A doctor's note will excuse the absence and keep the absence from counting towards LOC if and only if the student was present for part of the day.
- Student must be checked out by a parent/guardian if leaving or checked in by parent/guardian if returning from appointment.
- LOC of credit contracts are issued at the end of every semester.



Truancy

TEC § 25.095

If a student has unexcused absences on three days or parts of days within a four-week period, the student is subject to truancy prevention measures.

Truancy Prevention Measures

- Impose a behavior improvement plan
- Impose school-based community service
- Impose disciplinary action
- Refer student to truancy court

It is important that your child's absences be **excused**.
