Scholarships for the Month of December/January:

Dell Scholars Program:

Deadline: December 1st, 2020

Who is eligible to apply to the program?

To be eligible to apply for this scholarship you must meet the below listed criteria:

- Participating in a Michael & Susan Dell Foundation approved college readiness program in grades 11 and 12
- Graduating from an accredited high school this academic year
- Earning a minimum of a 2.4 GPA
- Demonstrated need for financial assistance and aid
- Eligible to receive a federal Pell grant in first year of college
- Planning to enroll full-time in a bachelor's degree program at an accredited higher education institution in the fall directly after your graduation from high school

How much is the Dell scholarship worth?

In addition to \$20,000, a laptop and textbook credits, Dell Scholars also receive "ongoing support and assistance to address all of the emotional, lifestyle, and financial challenges." This is a huge opportunity for students who are looking to receive both financial assistance, as well as a support system to help them succeed in college!

Denny's Hungry for Education Scholarships:

Deadline: December 11, 2020

Who is eligible to apply for the Denny's Hungry for Education Scholarships?

Applicants must be:

- Enrolled in an accredited high school or college in the United States or Puerto Rico
- Citizens or permanent residents of the United States or Puerto Rico
- Use the funds for education, such as tuition and related fees, books, supplies, and equipment required for courses
- Possess a minimum 2.5 GPA (high school and college). NOTE: Each partner organization may have additional requirements; however, GPA level varies
- Provide a 300-word essay (high school) or 500-word essay (college) on how Denny's can bring their communities together
- Meet GPA level and other requirements set by each partner organization

How much are these scholarships worth?

Over 25 scholarships worth from \$1,000 to \$3,000 awarded!

Generation Google Scholarship:

Deadline: December 4, 2020 at 11:59 pm PT.

The Generation Google Scholarship awards aspiring computer scientists who excel in technology with scholarships. Historically underrepresented groups, such as Black/African American, Hispanic/Latinx, American Indian, or Native Hawaiian/Pacific Islander students are especially encouraged to apply.

Who is eligible to apply for the Generation Google Scholarship?

All applicants must:

- Have a high school degree or equivalent, unless you are currently a high school senior applying to university
- Currently enrolled at an accredited university for the 2021-2022 academic year
- Intend to enroll in or accepted as a full-time student in a Bachelors, Masters or PhD program at a university in the United States or Canada for the 2020-2021 academic year
- Be studying computer science, computer engineering or a closely related technical field

- Demonstrate a strong academic record
- Exemplify leadership and demonstrate a passion for improving representation of underrepresented groups in computer science and technology

In order to apply, you will need a completed resume/CV, current official transcript, and a recommendation from a professor, instructor, teacher, advisor, or supervisor. In addition, there are four essay questions that will be a deciding factor in the final selection process (submit as a PDF).

How much are these scholarships worth?

Selected students in the United States will receive 10,000, and students in Canada will receive \$5,000. Recipients must use their awards for education related expenses such as tuition and books.

In addition to the monetary scholarship, current undergraduate or graduate students are invited to attend the Google Scholars' Retreat in the summer of 2020.

The committee selects award winners on the overall strength of their application materials as well as their written responses to the essay prompts in their peer group.

Deadline: December 15, 2020

Who is eligible to apply to Burger King Scholars Program?

There are a few eligibility requirements that scholarship applicants must fulfill:

- Be a citizen of the United States or Canada
- Have graduated from high school within the last three years

- Students who are applying as a full-time freshman to a four-year accredited, college or university that is located in the United States
- Cumulative unweighted grade point average (GPA) of at least 3.3
- Minimum ACT Composite score of 25 or a minimum combined SAT score of 1220
- Demonstrate an active leadership role in community service, athletics, and/or similar co-curricular activity
- Substantial work experience

How much are the Burger King Scholars Program awards?

Scholarship grants range from \$1,000 to a whopping \$50,000! All award checks will be mailed directly to the institution that the winners are/will attend.

Greater Texas Foundation Scholars Program:

Deadline: **Deadline is January 15, 2021**

Eligibility: To be eligible to apply for this grant, a student must:

- Be a 2021 graduate of a Texas ECHS
- Be a Texas resident
- Have been admitted to UTPB for Fall 2021
- Plan to earn a baccalaureate degree from UTPB
- Be eligible to apply for Free Federal Student Aid
- Have a cumulative GPA of 2.5 (on a 4 point scale) for college hours completed

The Coolidge Scholarship: A Scholarship for America:

Deadline: January 20, 2021

Eligibility Requirements

- 2021 Coolidge Scholarship applicants **must intend to enroll full-time at an accredited U.S. college or university as an undergraduate for the first time in fall 2022.** That is to say, students in their junior year of high school, or the equivalent if home schooled, are eligible to apply. (Students who are currently high school juniors but take some courses at a local college are indeed eligible to apply for the Coolidge Scholarship.)
- 2021 Coolidge Scholarship applicants **must be citizens or legal permanent residents of the United States of America** by the 2021 scholarship deadline.
- 2021 Coolidge Scholarship applicants **cannot be the immediate family member of any current employee or trustee of the Coolidge Scholars Program or the Calvin Coolidge Presidential Foundation.**
