Phlebotomy:

Phlebotomy technicians collect blood from patients and prepare the samples for testing.



Growing Demand:

The healthcare industry is one of the fastest growing in the nation, with employment of phlebotomists projected to grow 22 percent from 2020 to 2030 (U.S. Bureau)

Salary:

- ❖ The average salary for a phlebotomist is \$13.70 per hour in El Paso, TX.
- ❖ The average salary for a certified phlebotomist is \$17.15 per hour in Texas.

EPCC ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- ❖ Students must be 17 years old by the first day of class
- ❖ Current CPR (American Heart Association Healthcare Provider)
- ❖ Tested 10th grade reading level
- ❖ Physical exam by a licensed US physician or nurse practitioner
- ❖ Proof of measles, tetanus, and hepatitis B immunizations
- ❖ Negative TB test
- ❖ Background Clearance Drug Screen
