DESIGN OF NEW
SCHOOLS

The design of new schools in the District will be developed through the Department of District Operations.

Upon selection of an architect for a new school, the Assistant Superintendent of District Operations will facilitate the design phase of the building project. This will be accomplished by:

1. The appointment of a committee comprised of teachers, instructional specialists, campus and central office administrators, parents, and support staff to identify the programs and services that will be needed in the new building; and
2. Making a recommendation to the Facility Board Committee of the Board, which, upon approval, will forward the plans to the full Board for consideration.

The Assistant Superintendent of District Operations will make recommendations to both the Facility Board Committee and the full Board on the design of new school buildings.

MODIFICATIONS TO
EXISTING
FACILITIES

Any modifications, renovations, or additions to any campus facility must be reviewed by an Area Assistant Superintendent, then be approved by the Assistant Superintendent of District Operations and Director of District Operations before any project is to commence. This includes any projects related to the campus grounds or the plumbing, electrical, mechanical or structural aspects of any building.
