Instructors teaching all levels of AP courses must complete a five-day AP institute approved by the College Board. Instructors teaching Pre-AP classes for high school credit must complete all required initial and ongoing Pre-AP College Board trainings. Instructors teaching all other Pre-AP courses must attend a College Board approved training or a comparable training. Campuses are responsible for funding this professional development. Advanced Academics will monitor the attendance and completion of all Pre-AP/AP required trainings. Campus reimbursement is contingent on state funds available through the Texas Education Agency.

Instructors teaching all levels of Pre-AP/AP courses who are hired after the start of a new school year who have not previously attended a Pre-AP/AP institute (approved by the Southwestern Regional Office or the College Board of comparable training) must do so before the start of the next school year.

Instructors teaching all levels of Pre-IB/IB courses must complete the yearly update training required by the IB program. Campus reimbursement is contingent on state funds available through the Texas Education Agency. To the extent possible, previously trained instructors teaching all levels of Pre-IB/IB should attend institute training once every three (3) years.
