

# MONTWOOD MIDDLE DRESS CODE POLICY

## 2022-23 Uniform Policy

All registered students will comply with SISD's dress code policy as well as the Montwood Middle School Policy, as stated below. Dress Code Policy is established for the safety of all students and school personnel. MMS Administrators have the authority to make changes should something become a safety concern, distraction, or disruption that affects the learning or safety of the school environment.

SISD has established the following universal options to compliment other agreed upon school uniform options:

- Khaki pants with a white polo shirt without a school logo
- School uniform pants and a school-colored polo shirt without a school logo
- Physical education uniform bottoms (shorts or sweatpants in any color) and a white, gray, or school-colored T-shirt without a school logo.



As per Policy FNCA (LOCAL) a universal uniform may be worn at any SISD school which has elected to implement a school uniform policy.
