#### I. Title I / State Comp Ed

- **Extra Duty, Professional Development** – Monies have been designated and moved around to cover intersession/state comp ed. Transportation for intersession will be from Title I. #### II. Thursday Bell Schedule

- **Bell schedule** – This has been in progress for about six weeks – The Mastery period. It will begin this week on Thursday, but for the remainder of the year it will be on Wednesdays. The list of students who will be required to report to mastery rooms will be sent by Ms. Mendez. The second part of the period will cover literacy. This is where writing across the curriculum will come apply. There are approximately 150 students currently in the program. There will be an adjustment to this process. This is an endeavor to help raise scores significantly. It is intervention during the school day that targets the students who have not been targeted. Special education students will also be targeted through their sped teachers. There will be a team of people to be sure to round up students to ensure that the students report to their mastery room. Don't let students out of class prior to the mastery interventions. The hot-dogs and snow cones incentives were mentioned. The idea is similar to what use to be done in the ARMI periods. All classes will include the literacy strategies. Make students write. Everyone needs to do the reading and writing components. There will be walkthroughs.
