

SISD VOLUNTEER COACH CODE OF ETHICS

Professionalism

Although the job is voluntary, the commitment is professional. Besides being responsible for maintaining an attitude of mutual respect and confidence, you should become familiar with school and district rules, policies, and practices.

Dependability

Students, parents, and administrators count on you and rely on the services performed by you as a volunteer. It is essential that you contact your area coordinator if you are unable to volunteer on your scheduled day, so that other arrangements can be made.

Confidentiality

Volunteers must protect the students and parents right to privacy. You may not disclose school affairs or personal matters which have come to your attention. Discuss student/parent problems only with your area coordinator or VASSP Supervisor.

Punctuality

Always arrive on time for any volunteer activity. Again, if you will not be able to make it, communicate with your area coordinator or the VASSP Supervisor.

Attitude

Please come to volunteer/coach with a good attitude, one that will say to the parents, students, and administrators, "I'm glad to be here and I'm glad to be doing this."

Support

As volunteers we are always in a support position. We support the students, parents, school, area coordinators and the VASSP Supervisor. Principals are ultimately responsible for the education of all students and all activities at the campus.
