Classes will begin remotely on August 17th

- Login to TEAMS on time at the scheduled time.
- Attendance will be taken during each class period.
- Tardies will apply if student does not login on time.
- Be prepared with supplies at home.
- No cell phones during instruction unless using for lessons.
- Find a quiet place, free from distractions (siblings, pets, television).



Classes will begin remotely on August 17th

- Uniform shirts are highly encouraged.
- Students must dress appropriately.
- Cameras must remain on to promote focus.
- Stay on mute. Please click the “raise hand” button to participate unless called upon.
- Refrain from eating or drinking in front of the camera.
- Always maintain respect, use appropriate language.

Students who will be returning to school-TBD

- Arrive to school on time.
- Tardies will apply for students arriving late.
- Be prepared with all supplies as sharing of supplies is not allowed at this time.
- No cell phones, headphones, or air pods unless teacher instructs to use.
- Adhere to the school dress code.
 - 1.No hoodies, zip up sweaters only
 - 2.No ripped jeans
 - 3.No slippers or slides, tennis shoes only.

All dress code violations will be reported to the office.

COVID-19 Health and Safety Guidelines when/if students return to school.

- Temperatures will be checked every day upon entering school.
- If student is not feeling well, please stay home.
- Students will enter and exit the school in specific designated areas.
- Masks are required at all times.
- Students will maintain 6ft distance at all times.
- Students will not transition to classes, teachers will transition.
- Lunch will be eaten in the classroom.

Students must be responsible for washing hands, sanitizing, not removing masks and no sharing of supplies.



Attendance

- To obtain course credit, students in the secondary level must continue to attend all classes at a minimum of 90% for the school year to receive credit and be promoted. Therefore, student attendance will be required to be taken in each class period every day at the secondary level to comply with the 90% attendance rule in the Texas Education
- If no measure of engagement can be documented during a particular day through any of the above means, the student must be counted as absent.



Grading Policy

- We will be returning to the traditional grading policy of 0 to 100.
- Intervention classes will be pass or fail.
- Failure to turn in work when due will result in loss of points.
- It is very important for students to communicate with their teachers regarding inability to turn in work when due.
- As per TEA, 8th grade students will take the Reading, Math, Science, and Social Studies STAAR test, with only one administration.

Disciplinary Actions

- 1st offense
 - verbal warning, discussion with student.
- 2nd offense
 - phone call to parent/guardian.
- 3rd offense
 - referral and parent/teacher conference.


Supplies One Pager
